

BILINGUAL TEACHER OF THE YEAR

The California Association for Bilingual Education recognizes that there are many outstanding bilingual classroom teachers in California. This award is in recognition of those educators who have made contributions to Bilingual Education beyond the normal scope of their assigned responsibilities. At the 1998 CABE conference in San Jose, three exemplary classroom bilingual teachers will be honored for their excellence, dedication and promotion of Bilingual Education.

Each CABE chapter is invited to submit one nominee for the bilingual teacher of the year award. A committee of CABE regional representatives will select three honorees from the submitted applicants.

The three honorees will receive complimentary registration, round-trip transportation and one night's lodging. A plaque and an award of \$1,000 to the winner and \$500 to the two honorees will be presented at the CABE conference luncheon on Friday, February 6,1998. The winners will be filmed in their classrooms and short videos will be shown at Friday's luncheon.

The winner will be selected as the California representative for the 1999 National Association for Bilingual Education (NABE) Teacher of the Year Award. The California representative will receive:

- complimentary NABE registration
- complimentary transportation
- complimentary lodging for two nights
- \$300 in scholarships for their local CABE chapter

The three honorees will be notified on or before December 1, 1997. The selection of the California representative will be announced at the conference during the luncheon on Friday, February 6, 1998.

Nomination criteria

Each nominee must meet all of the following criteria to be considered for this award:

- 1. Current CABE member
- 2. Currently a bilingual classroom teacher (Pre K 12)
- 3. Minimum of three years bilingual teaching experience
- 4. California bilingual teaching credential (except Pre K teachers)
- 5. Outstanding contributions to bilingual education
- 6. A philosophy that reflects cultural sensitivity and high expectations
- 7. Promotion of bilingual education proven practices and research
- 8. Nominated by a CABE chapter
- 9. Submission of complete portfolio

Portfolio requirements

Four complete copies of a nonreturnable portfolio must be submitted. Also, one nonreturnable black and white photo, preferably glossy, size 5" x 6". A maximum of 10 typed pages will only be accepted.

Portfolio must include the following:


- 1. Nomination cover letter signed by CABE chapter officer
- 2. Biographical resume (2 pages maximum)
- 3. Candidate's statement of philosophy on bilingual education
- 4. Community service
- 5. CABE service
- 6. Letter of recommendation from immediate supervisor
- 7. Two (2) letters of recommendation from others known to candidate
- 8. Video segment (3-5 min.) showing the teacher interacting in classroom (only 1 tape required)

Please be aware that the selected California representative will have his/her portfolio submitted for the 1999 National Association for Bilingual Education (NABE) Teacher of the Year Award.

STUDENT WRITING CONTEST

The Student Writing Contest for the CABE '98 Conference in San José, California, will focus on the many advantages of being bilingual. The Student Writing Contest theme is "Bilingual Education & Technology: Pathways to Success".

Students are encouraged to approach this writing contest in an imaginative and meaningful manner expressing themselves in either their primary language or second language. Teachers can assist students in focusing on the theme by exploring how being bilingual and working with technology will enhance their opportunities for learning, careers, leadership, diverse social interaction, self-esteem, family unity and support, as well as cultural legacy, etc. The usage of the writing process is encouraged (prewriting, sharing, revising, editing, and evaluating) to develop a meaningful and expressive literary piece. Each literary piece should focus on the theme and demonstrate final editing quality.

All students who enter the writing contest will be acknowledged for their efforts. Winners will be selected by a committee in four grade level categories K-2nd, 3rd-5th,6th-8th and 9th-12th, based on the following criteria:

- Content
- How well the writing captures the essence of the theme,
 - "Bilingual Education & Technology: Pathways to Success"
- Language
- The use of expressive, authentic, rich language

developed by the student.

Genre

The creative use of literary forms (such as short essay, poetry, narrative, biography

or song)

Please read the following directions for submitting student writings:

- Writings should be typed double-spaced, three pages maximum.
- Student writings in any language may be submitted. Translations must accompany the entry with an explanation as to who translated the writing piece. Translations may not improve or alter the original writing.
- · Students must have been in a bilingual program at some time during the last three years.
- Winners will be notified by December 5, 1997, and will be asked to submit a black and white photo for the conference program booklet.
- Winners will read their essay at the CABE '98 StudentWriting Contest luncheon, Thursday, February 5.
- Savings Bonds will be awarded to the division winners in categories K-2nd, 3rd-5th, 6th-8th.
- The winner for the 9-12th grade category will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.
- Winners will receive transportation (if needed) to the CABE Conference Student Awards Luncheon for themselves, two family members (one must be an adult) and one teacher.
