

1. FAMILY LITERACY (K-12)

A. FAMILY LITERACY PROGRAMS are intergenerational literacy programs that involve parents and their children. The Program's focus is on literacy strategies parents and other adults can use at home to develop and maintain oral language and literacy skills. Parents also participate in trainings designed to develop and augment parenting skills.

2. ELEMENTARY PROGRAMS

- A. SPANISH Two-Way BILINGUAL/DUAL IMMERSION: These programs have a strong, comprehensive instructional design that includes English Language Development, primary language instruction and SDAIE (Specially Designed Academic Instruction in English/other non-English language). There are two language groups represented in the Two-Way classroom: English Learners and English proficient students who serve as language models for each other during the instructional day. The goal of this program at the elementary level is to promote high levels of bilingualism/biliteracy in two languages.
- B. Mandarin One-way Foreign Language Immersion: Foreign Language Immersion programs provide foreign language instruction in which the regular school curriculum is taught through the medium of the foreign language. The foreign language is the vehicle for content instruction; it is not the subject of instruction. Total immersion is one type of program model for foreign language immersion. There are several models with a range on a range or continuum in terms of instructional time spent in the foreign language.

3. MIDDLE SCHOOL PROGRAMS

A. Two-Way BILINGUAL/DUAL IMMERSION: This program is for both English Learners and English Only students at the middle school level. Students interact as language models for each other. The goal for all students is that they learn English and meet grade-appropriate academic achievement standards for grade promotion and graduation; and become bi-literate and multicultural scholars.

4. HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS

- A. ENGLISH LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT (ELD) AND SPECIALLY DESIGNED ACADEMIC INSTRUCTION IN ENGLISH (SDAIE) Students at the secondary level continue to learn more difficult listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in English through English Language Arts and English Language Development (ELD) Instruction. Students received instruction and primary language support, if reasonably possible and as needed, in math, science, and history/social science from specially trained teachers using SDAIE strategies.
- B. Two-Way Bilingual/Dual Immersion: This program is for both English Learners and English Only high school students who have begun to develop biliteracy skills in earlier grades. At the secondary level, models vary by content area and amount of coursework offered in the partner language. Students interact as language models for each other. The goal for all students is that they learn English as well as the partner language, and meet grade-appropriate academic achievement standards for graduation; and become bi-literate and multicultural scholars.
- c. World Languages in the 21st Century: Foreign language instruction in the 21st Century actively engages students in language learning through a variety of strategies and best practices to support language acquisition and cultural competencies. The most effective classrooms incorporate meaningful and purposeful activities that provide students with opportunities to use world languages in active communication as well as address the integration of culture into the curriculum and desired student outcomes.


