

#1 K-5 and 6-8 DUAL **LANGUAGE IMMERSION PROGRAMS**

The Dual Language Immersion Program is designed to ensure both Multilingual Learners and English proficient students develop high levels of English and target program language proficiency and literacy, as well as academic competency. In kindergarten, instruction will occur approximately 80% of the time in the program target language. The percentage of instruction in English increases from year to year. Choose: 1A - K-5, Spanish;

1B - 6-8, Spanish; 1C - 6-8, Mandarin)

#2 K-5 BILITERACY PROGRAM

(Spanish)

Biliteracy schools are designed to ensure Multilingual Learners develop high levels of English and home language proficiency and literacy, as well as high levels of academic competency. The Biliteracy Program provides an effective academic program for Multilingual Learners. In kindergarten and 1st grade, the target language of the program is used for approximately 50 - 70% of the instruction. Instruction in English increases each year. By the 5th grade, instruction is at least 50% - 70% in English.

#3 HIGH SCHOOL **NEWCOMER PROGRAM**

Newcomer Programs are designed to help newly arrived immigrant Multilingual Learners to adjust to their new language and culture. They receive more intensive English Language Development supports, along with primary language supports and referrals to support services.



#4 K-8 DUAL LANGUAGE **IMMERSION PROGRAM**

Two K-8 schools maintain the Dual Language Immersion model through 8th grade with two academic classes taught in the target language in the middle grades. These programs are designed for students who are native speakers of the pathway language, native English speakers, and bilingual students. Choose: 4A - Chinese; 4B - Spanish
