The theme for this year's writing contest is:

Grades K - 2nd and 3rd - 5th

How does being bilingual help you get to know and understand people from other cultures and languages?

- Students are encouraged to approach their writing with an imaginative and meaningful manner, expressing themselves in both English and their second language.
- The use of the writing process is encouraged (prewriting, sharing, revising, editing, and publishing) to develop a meaningful and expressive literary piece.

Grades 6th - 8th and 9th - 12th

How does being bilingual influence your perception of other cultures and languages and promote unity in your school and/or community?

- All essays must be submitted online.
- Teachers and parents can support students in focusing on the theme by exploring how their bilingual/biliteracy skills will enhance their future opportunities and make their dreams come true.
- Each literary piece should focus on the theme and demonstrate final editing quality.
