ADMINISTRATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

Criteria

- Currently an administrator (Pre K-12)
- Minimum of five years as an administrator in a capacity providing service to English learners
- Outstanding contributions to education and English learner programs
- A philosophy that reflects cultural sensitivity and high expectations
- Promotion of bilingual education proven practices and research on English learners
- Must be a CABE member through March 31, 2023

TEACHER OF THE YEAR AWARD

One exemplary bilingual teacher who has made contributions to bilingual education and English learners beyond the normal scope of their assigned responsibilities will be honored.

Recipient will be given the date of the award presentation in official notification letter.

Criteria

- Currently a bilingual classroom teacher (Pre K-12)
- Minimum of three years bilingual teaching experience
- California bilingual teacher credential (except Pre K teachers) or certification
- Outstanding contributions to bilingual education
- A philosophy that reflects cultural sensitivity and high expectations
- Promotion of bilingual education proven practices and research on English learners
- Must be a CABE member through March 31, 2023

PARAEDUCATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

One exemplary bilingual paraeducator (classified staff: instructional assistant, parent liaison, teacher's aide, classroom assistant, etc.) who has made contributions to bilingual education and English learners beyond the normal scope of their assigned responsibilities will be honored.

Recipient will be given the date of the award presentation in official notification letter.

Criteria

- Currently a bilingual paraeducator having quality contact with English learners and parents
- Has served as a paraeducator for at least two years
- Outstanding contributions to bilingual education and English learner programs
- Promotion of bilingual education and a philosophy that reflects cultural sensitivity and high expectations for English learners and parents
- Must be a CABE member through March 31, 2023

PARENT OF THE YEAR AWARD

One exemplary bilingual parent leader who has made significant contributions to their child's school on behalf of biliteracy and English learners will be honored .

Minimum of two years of proactive parent and family engagement and leadership serving in:

- Classrooms
- School Site Committees/Councils
- Community
- District Committees/Councils
- Must be a CABE member through March31, 2023

The Student Writing Contest for the CABE 2023 Annual Conference, will focus on the many advantages of being bilingual/biliterate.

The theme for this year's writing contest is:

Grades K-2 and 3-5

How does being bilingual/multilingual help you share the stories and dreams that you, your family, and community have?

Grades 6-8 and 9-12

How does being bilingual/multilingual provide you with the tools to tell the stories and share the art and dreams in your life, in your family, and in your community?

1. Students are encouraged to approach their writing in an imaginative and meaningful manner, expressing themselves in both English and their second language.
2. The use of the writing process is encouraged (prewriting, sharing, revising, editing, and publishing) to develop a meaningful and expressive essay.
3. All essays must be submitted online.
4. Teachers and parents can support students in focusing on the theme by exploring how their bilingual/biliteracy skills will enhance their future opportunities and make their dreams come true.
5. Each essay should focus on the theme and demonstrate final editing quality.


