

CABE 2026 Conference Highlights Include:

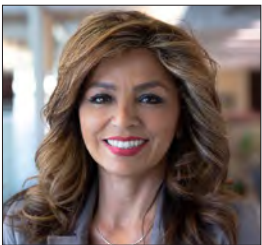

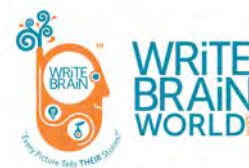

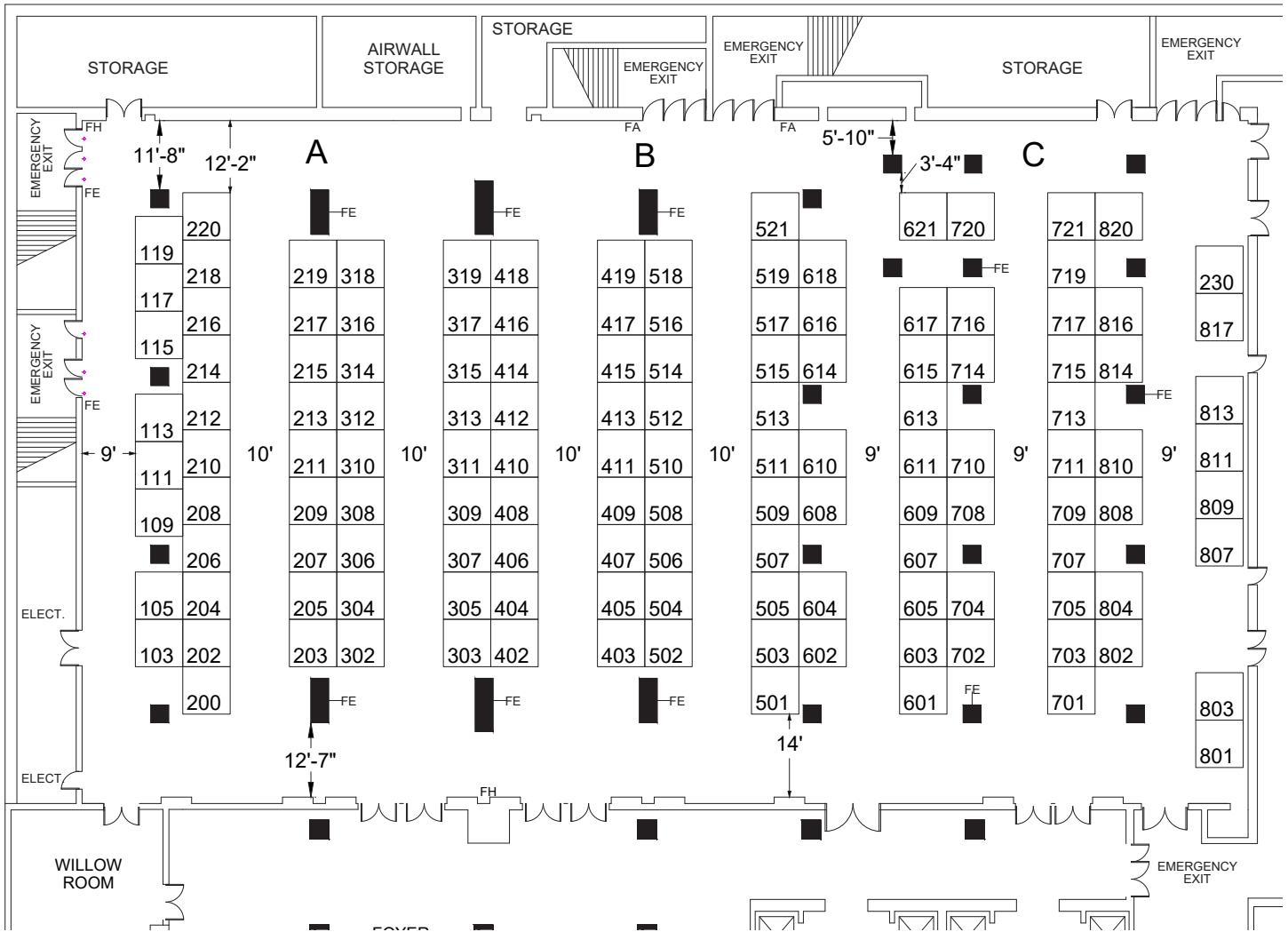
